



## **The iNEER Website Instructions**

### **DIRECTORY AND REPOSITORY USAGE**

Users are invited and urged to key in information about themselves into the database.

The information is protected by a password, chosen by each user that allows the user, and nobody else, to access the information to update it when necessary. Other users can see the information but not alter it.

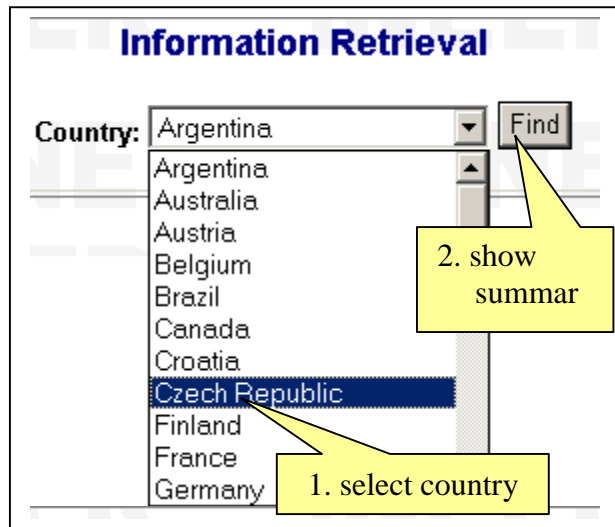
If you have submitted an abstract to an ICEE conference, you may already have an entry in Directory; however, you will need to access the Directory using the User ID or Password provided by the webmaster on the list adjacent to this computer.

Please look for your user id or password and enter the Directory to update information about yourself and provide a summary of your work, so others may contact you for possible interaction.

### **ACCESS TO DIRECTORY**

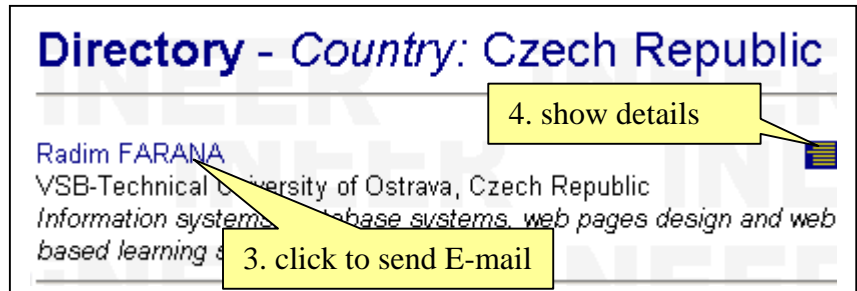
To access the Directory, start at the iNEER Homepage from the URL given at the top of the page, and click on the Directory logo.

Users then have the option to choose “Information Retrieval” or “Information Input.”



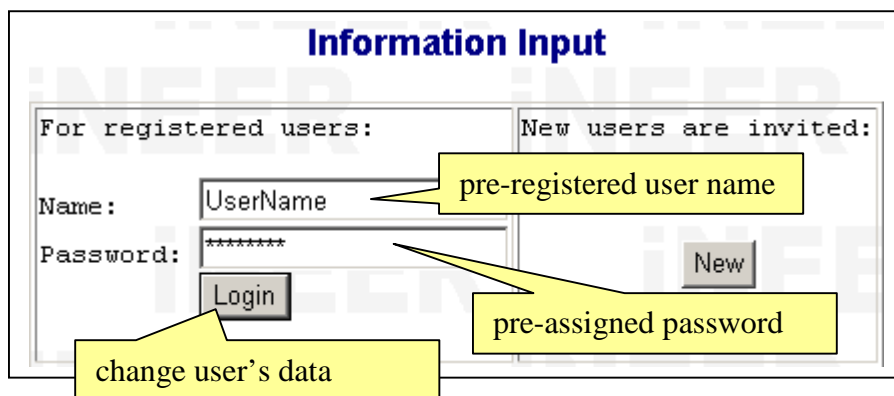
To retrieve information from the Directory, users first key in the name of the country (1). Current entries from the selected country are displayed in summary form (2). The summary contains the name, affiliation and fields of interest of the individual. To send an e-mail to any individual, click on the name (3). To display the

complete information on that individual, click on the button to the right of his/her name (4).



To input new information or change current information, a user selects Information Input from the Directory webpage. A password is selected and retained by the user for future access to the Directory when the information must be updated.

To update existing entries for the first time, pre-registered users must employ pre-assigned passwords (they can change it).




Only registered users can access their own data for updating or deletion.
