- **2 PRINTED COPIES** and an **ELECTRONIC COPY of ABSTRACTS**
- **EXPERT'S REPORT** that authorizes the publication of the abstracts in the open press sources
- **INFORMATION ABOUT AUTHORS:** family name/name, position, organization, scientific degree, academic status, address, phone and E-mail

ORGANIZATION MATTERS

Administrative fees of school organizing are in charge of the Organizing Committee ITCS-2006. **There is no organization fees for the participants of the school.**

ACCOMODATION

Participants of the school are invited to pay the accommodation and meals of approximately **120 USD**. Payment should be made at the registration desk of the International school.

TYPOGRAPHY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PAPERS ABSTRACTS

Please, send **TWO PRINTED COPIES** of papers abstracts in Russian or English language up to **three complete pages A4** (210x297 mm).

The paper should be made in MS Word with the following settings: bottom margin – 3 cm, top and right margins – 2,5 cm; single-spaced type; base font – Times New Roman, 12 pt; break line (indent) – 0,5 cm; running title: top – 1,7 cm, bottom – 2 cm. Boundary alignment fully-justified.

Papers abstracts formatting:

1st line – **title** centered in capitalized in Arial – 14 pt., Roman type, boldface font,

2nd line – blank line in Times New Roman, 10 pt.

3rd line – **author(s) name(s)** centered lowercase letters boldface font Times New Roman, 14 pt.

4th line – blank line Times New Roman, 8 pt.

5th line – **country, city and abbreviation of the organization** (enumeration with commas) centered in italicized Times New Roman, 12 pt.

6th line – **E-mail** centered in italicized Times New Roman, 12 pt.

7th line – blank line in Times New Roman, 14 pt.

8th line and so on – new paragraph (break line) **main text** of the abstract.

Figures and tables could have free formats.

When **formulas are made in Equation**, please use the following settings: common – 14 pt; indexes: large 11pt, small – 9 pt; symbols: large – 18 pt, small – 12 pt.

The List of References is formatted in a common way: headline “Literature” should be spaced out and centered in boldface font Times New Roman, 14 pt with one blank line from the text.

The abstracts should be printed in a laser or inkjet printer on a high quality white paper. Please, paginate with a pencil in the right top margin corner.

The ELECTRONIC COPY of the abstracts is to be sent to the Organizing Committee e-mail.
